



SUPERFRUIT'S PRUNES MARKET REPORT

Year-to-date shipments of prunes have been faster than in the previous two years. This is mainly due to the available volume from the 2023 season, and the important demand from China. New crop shipments usually start in April.

In proportion to the global volume, Chile is increasing the volume of unpitted prunes vs pitted prunes exports by 15% until to week 15. We have seen an increase in unpitted prunes exports since the 2022 season.

The primary market for pitted prunes until week 15 in 2024 has been Poland, China and United States, with an increase of 114%, 55% and 268% respectively. This means 1,682 tons more considering these three countries in comparison to 2023.

On the other hand, there has been a decrease of 41% in Chilean exports to Germany during the first quarter in comparison to 2023 pitted prunes exports.

We can also observe an increasing trend in the exported volume during the first quarter in 2024 compared to 2023 in almost all top markets for pitted prunes. As mentioned, this is due to the pending volume to be shipped from the 2023 season.

Regarding unpitted prunes during the first quarter of 2024, Chilean exports to China have once again increased by over 400% compared to the volume exported in the same period in 2023.

The largest decrease in unpitted prunes exports has been to Mexico and Brazil, with a diminution of 85% and 71% respectively until week 15.

Regarding the 2024 harvest, Chile estimates 65,000 tons of the new crop available volume plus an estimated carryover of 14,000 tons from the 2023 season. The harvest was lower than expected in term of volume, with a decrease in the availability of larger sizes. The industry estimates that around 85% of the 2024 season is committed year to date (June 2024).

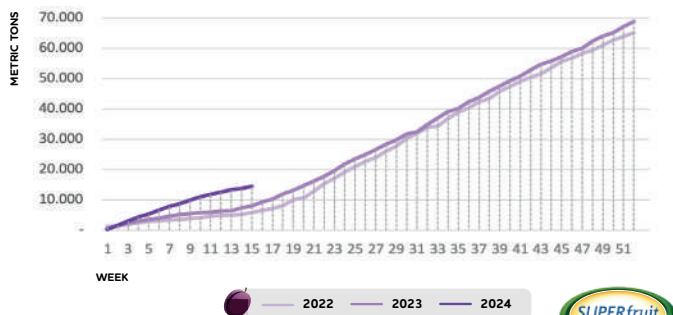

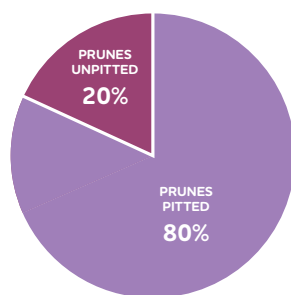

CHILEAN PRUNES SHIPMENT PER MONTH



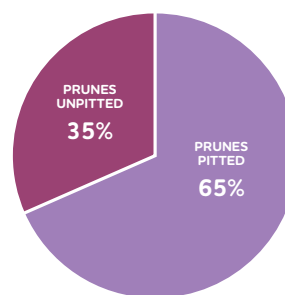

CHILEAN PRUNES SHIPMENTS 2023 UNTIL WEEK 15

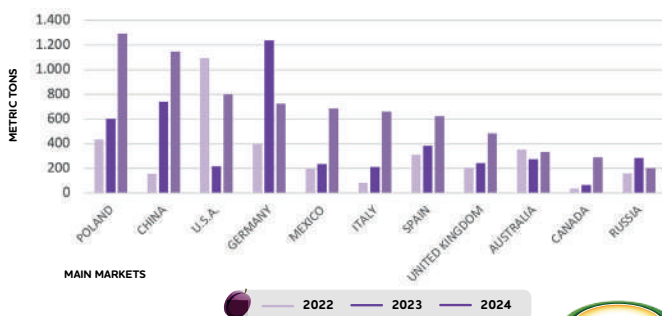

CHILEAN PRUNES SHIPMENTS 2024 UNTIL WEEK 15

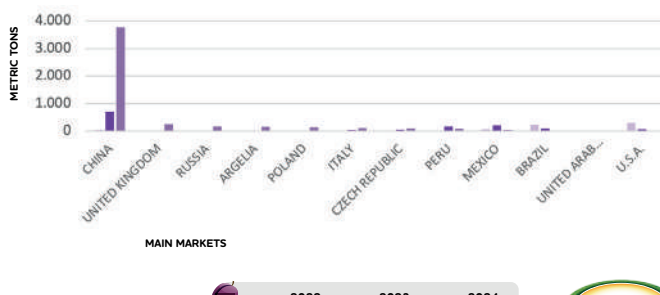


CHILEAN PITTED PRUNES SHIPMENTS UNTIL WEEK 15
